### Tips:

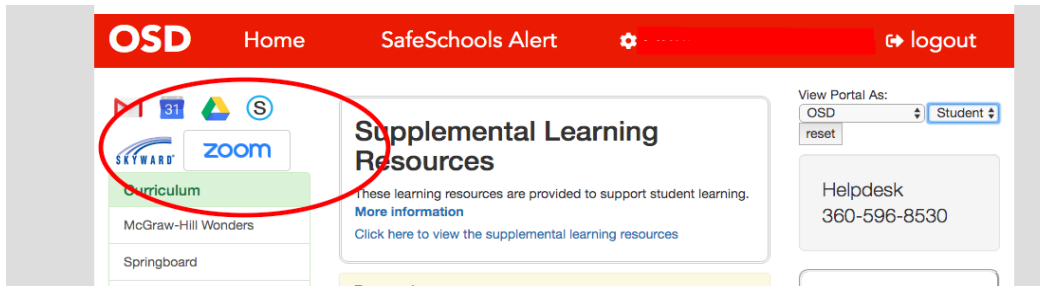
- Make sure you are joining the meeting for the correct day. Each day has a different code and password.

## Steps to join ZOOM using the link:

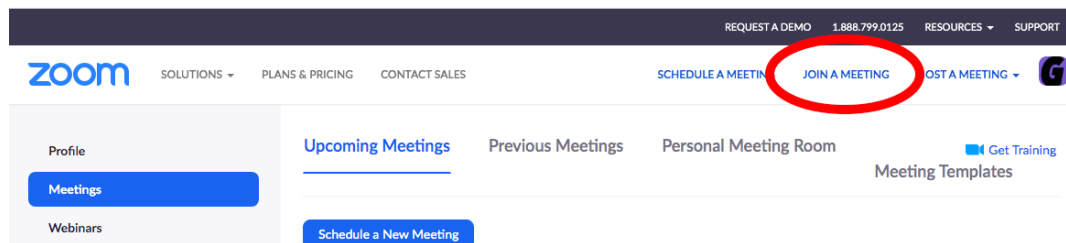
1. Click on the link or copy/paste it into a browser.
2. Wait for the teacher to admit you from the waiting room

## Steps to join ZOOM using the Meeting ID/Password:

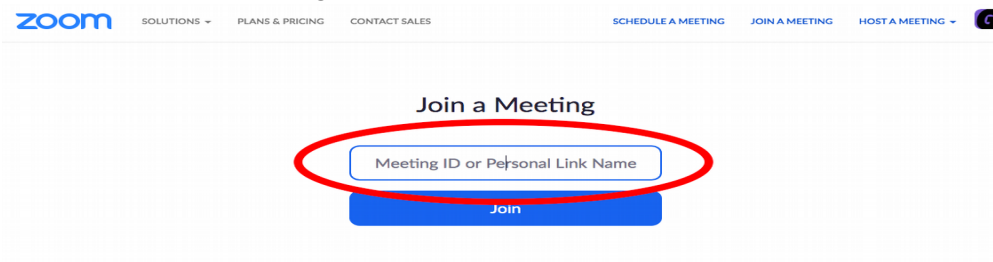
1. Go to the OSD Portal and click on the ZOOM button at the top left.



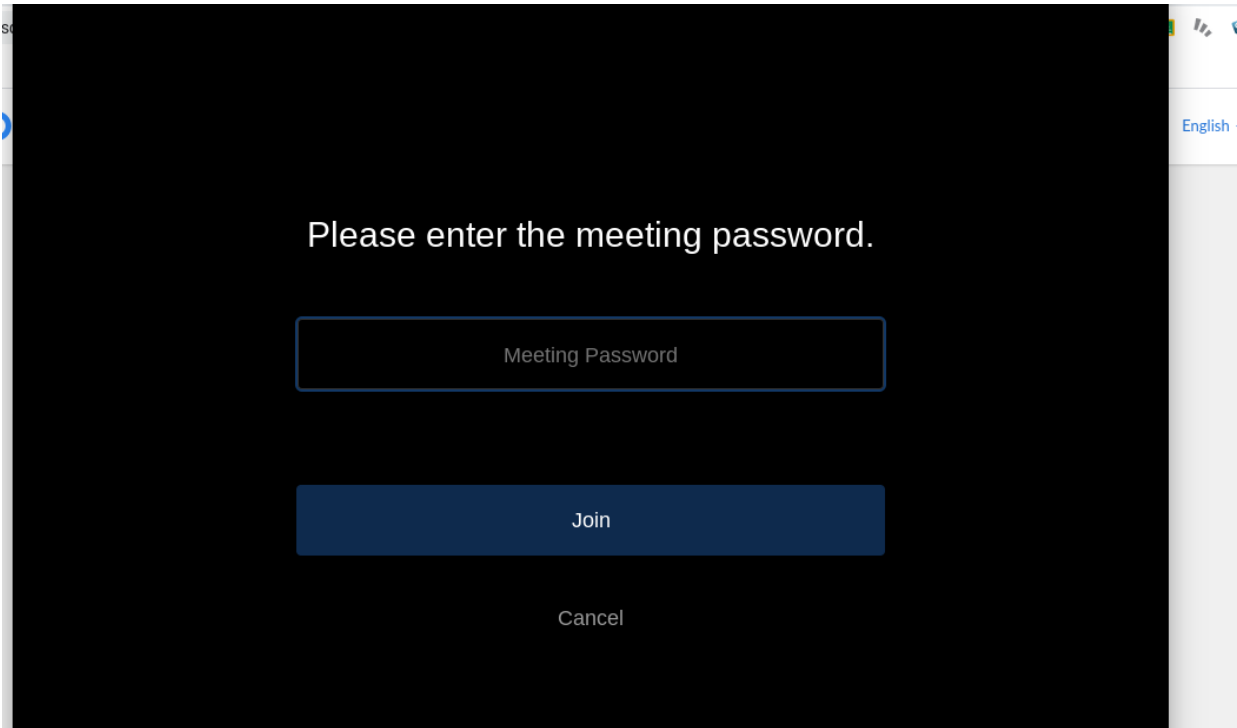
2. Choose Join a Meeting near the top right.



3. Enter the Meeting ID.

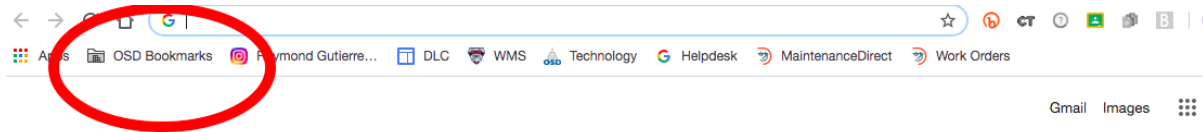


4. Enter the password and wait for the teacher to admit you from the waiting room.

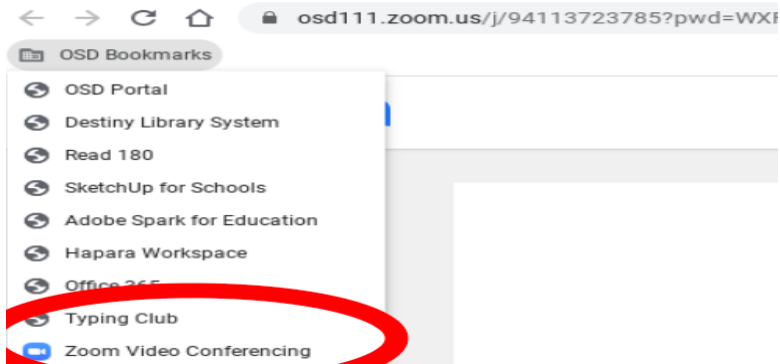


## Steps to join ZOOM using the OSD Bookmark with a Chromebook:
