# 2021-22 School Year Information

#### PE:

All students enrolled in physical education classes will be required to wear a WMS t-shirt. If families have not already purchased one, they can purchase one for **\$7.00**. Students are also required to wear court shoes for PE classes. Locker rooms will be available for students before and after their PE class. A combination lock is needed for these lockers.

#### Lockers:

PE lockers and band/orchestra lockers will be available. Hallway lockers will NOT be available until later in the year. Students will be carrying their backpacks to each class throughout the day.

#### Breakfast/Lunch:

Free breakfast and lunch are available to ALL students for the entire year.

## **Athletics Information:**

Boys soccer and girls volleyball are the fall sports offered for 7th and 8th-grade students, beginning Monday, September 13 and ending Friday, November 5. Please sign up using the following link: <a href="Sports Clearance Process">Sports Clearance Process</a>

Practice will be after school until 5:15 pm, every day with the exception of early release Wednesdays when there are no after-school activities. Games will be on Mondays and Thursdays and dates will be shared once schedules are finalized.

#### Attendance:

Please call the attendance line at **360-596-3003** by **10:00 a.m.** to notify the school if your child will not be in attendance. Messages can be left on the attendance line 24 hours a day. When leaving a message, please state the student's full name and a brief description of the absence (illness, dental appointment, etc). **All students arriving on campus after the start of the school day must check in with the office.** 

### Social Distancing/Masks:

Masks - All students, staff, and visitors must wear properly fitting masks at all times except while eating. Masks must cover the mouth and nose. Students who refuse to wear their masks properly will be sent home.

Distancing - Students will continue to sit 3 feet apart in classrooms and 6 feet apart at lunch. Movement around the building will be limited and supervised.

Daily Attestations - We will no longer take student temperatures daily or ask for attestations. However, we will still have a COVID isolation room and continue to have an RN on-site every day.

#### **Arrival Time:**

Washington Middle School is open to students at <u>8:55 AM.</u> Please refrain from dropping off students early. Students will be directed to move directly to their 1st-period class upon entry to the building. Students will also need to be off-campus by 3:55 PM unless in a supervised activity.

## Student Drop Off and Pick up:

Families dropping off and picking up students are to use the Cain Road entrance. The Boulevard Road entrance is reserved for buses and emergency vehicles only.

### **Lunch Schedule:**

To meet social distancing requirements of 6 feet while eating, we must offer four overlapping lunches. Each student's lunchtime will take place during their 4th period. Students will be able to tell you which of the four lunchtimes they have once school starts.

## Advisory:

Students will continue to meet in an Advisory class this year every Wednesday for 25 minutes. During this time, our teachers will be focusing on equity work, academic support, and social-emotional learning.

#### Chromebooks:

Students are reminded to bring their **fully charged** Chromebooks to school each day.
